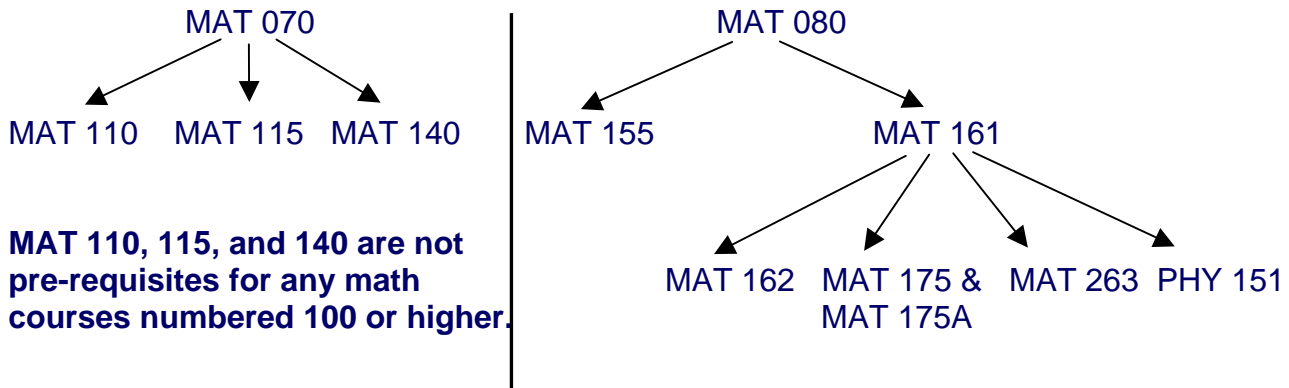


Math/Physics Courses

Please check the student's math placement scores or transcripts from other institutions (to look for courses in which the student has earned a C or higher.) If placed incorrectly, the student will be removed from class.

Sequence of Most Commonly Taken Math and Physics Courses



AST 111 & PHY 110: English 095 is the pre-requisite for AST 111 & PHY 110. Both of these courses have a lab requirement AST 111A & PHY 110A.

Students who register for any AST, GEL, and PHY course need to register for the appropriate section of lab. (For example, students who register for a day class are required to register for a day lab; students who register for a night class are required to register for a night lab.)

MAT 175 & 175A: Pre-calculus is not for everyone. Although MAT 175 meets the math requirement for AA students, it does not complete the math requirement for AS students: it is only their first math course. The local pre-requisite for MAT 175 is MAT 161.

MAT 140: Survey of Mathematics is NOT recommended. This course meets the math requirements for the AA student, but it is not the required math at most universities. **Also, it is not a bridge to MAT 161, or any other course with a MAT 080 pre-requisite.** Pre-education majors most commonly take MAT 140.

Students who have successfully completed MAT 122 will be given permission to take any class with a MAT 080 pre-requisite.
