NURSE ASSISTANT II
(168 Hours)

Description of Course:

The Nurse Assistant II Course prepares graduates to perform more complex skills for patients or residents regardless of setting. Emphasis on infection control including principles of sterile technique and dressing changes for wounds over 48 hours; elimination procedures including catheterizations, and care of established tracheotomy care; observation and maintenance of oxygen therapy, enteral nutrition for existing infusions and roles of the Nurse Assistant II with members of the health care team. The course includes class, laboratory, and clinical learning experiences. Upon satisfactory completion of the course and skill/competency evaluation, the graduate is eligible to apply for listing as a Nurse Assistant II by the North Carolina Board of Nursing. In all employment settings, the Nurse Assistant II will work under the direction and supervision of licensed personnel.

1. Copy of high school transcript or Diploma or GED.
2. We will pull copy of registry listing of NA I with the Division of Health Services Regulation from computer.
3. Must have taken a Placement Test within the last three years and have scores 32-51 in Reading and 22-45 in Math for Compass and for asset 34-37 in reading and 34-41 for Math for Accuplacer 30 + in Math and Reading. For Testing please call 493-7561. **Please call Glenda Cannon at 493-7225 for information on the Nursing Assistant II Program.** No testing is required if you bring proof of college Math/English.
4. Must bring **copies** of following verifications:
 - a. Varicella (chicken pox) (positive history or titer documented)
 - b. Rubella or positive titer (German measles)
 - c. Rubeola (measles) 1 dose and (2 doses after 1st birthday for any person born after 1957) or positive titer
 - d. Mumps (1 dose for any person born on or after January 1, 1957) or positive titer
 - e. PPD Skin Test (TB) (have done each year)
 - f. (1) Chest x-ray and INH if PPD is positive (2) Chest x-ray if known to be PPD positive in the past
5. Copies of current Healthcare Provider CPR, Driver License and Social Security Card
6. **All students must go to www.certifiedbackground.com to do a background check. \$34 for NC residents only: Code is pi06. Out of State cost is \$59.00: Code is pi06os**
