Specific conditions that require exclusion according to NC Child Care Laws and Rules are:

- \_\_\_\_\_ Fever greater than 100 degrees F (underarm) fever-free for 24 hours
- \_\_\_\_\_ Diarrhea (↑ # of bowel movements & stool water) diarrhea-free for 24 hours
- \_\_\_\_\_ Vomiting (2 or more episodes in 12 hour period) vomiting-free for 24 hours
- \_\_\_\_\_ Red eye with white or yellow eye discharge 24 hours after treatment
- \_\_\_\_\_ Scabies or lice after treatment\*\*
- \_\_\_\_\_ Chicken pox all blisters have dry scabs (approx. 1 week)\*\*
- \_\_\_\_\_ Tuberculosis doctor states that the child is not infectious\*\*
- \_\_\_\_\_ Strep throat (scarlet fever) 24 hours after antibiotic treatment\*\*
- \_\_\_\_\_ Pertussis 5 days after appropriate antibiotic treatment\*\*
- \_\_\_\_\_ Hepatitis A viral infection 1 week after onset of illness or jaundice
- \_\_\_\_\_ Impetigo 24 hours after treatment\*\*
- \_\_\_\_\_ When a physician or other health professional issues a written order that the child be separated from other children.

Other conditions:

- \_\_\_\_\_ Hand, foot, and mouth disease child should not stay home unless not feeling well enough to participate\*\*
- \_\_\_\_\_ E. coli or Giardiasis exclude until no diarrhea
- \_\_\_\_\_ Measles (rubeola) exclude for at least 4 days after rash appears
- \_\_\_\_\_ Meningitis (bacterial) exclude until medical treatment is complete.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Meningitis (viral) no exclusion, return when well enough
- \_\_\_\_\_ Mono exclude if fever, ok if child feels like participating
- \_\_\_\_\_ Mumps exclude until all symptoms have disappeared (9 days after swelling appears)\*\*
- \_\_\_\_\_ Pinworms return after initial dose of medication\*\*
- \_\_\_\_\_ Ringworm may return after treatment with fungicidal ointment (oral antibiotic required if in the scalp-bring doctor's note or medication to readmit)\*\*
- \_\_\_\_\_ Roseola (infantum) exclude if fever, otherwise ok if child feels like participating in activities\*\*
- \_\_\_\_\_ Rubella (German Measles) exclude at least 7 days after appearance of rash
- \_\_\_\_\_ Salmonellosis return when symptoms and diarrhea end
- \_\_\_\_\_ Shigellosis exclude child during acute illness
